NOTES:

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[1] IVF charges vary enormously. The figures here are estimates of our lesser expensive clinics.

[2] This fee is required to cover the extra resources required for the evaluation and administration of their insurance policies. This extra fee will also cover any potential correspondence and administrative hearings that are sometimes required to secure payment from insurance companies that contest the carrier's eligibility.

[3] This is the total of all charges that are expected and the number that clients should consider as the likely minimum charges for your egg donor surrogacy. Anyone coming into the program should be prepared for 10 to 20% above this number since travel, second transfers and twins are common occurrences and can substantially add to this number. To account for this, we collect a \$3,000 advance on travel expenses and a \$2,000 advance on other possible expenses as part of the first half agency fee. These are only used if needed, and will be returned if not. As they are simply advances on some of the potential contingent expenses, they are not separately identified above or below.

[4] While the costs above are to be expected, the costs below are possible extras. No one in our program has ever had to pay all of the expenses listed here, and some get by without ever paying any of the expenses listed here. We do not collect any of the other sums dictated by chance as part of the trust fund, but will collect those that may be dictated by the circumstances of your carrier and/or donor and those that may be created by choices you have made. **The most common extras are second transfers of \$5,100 (happens about 30% of the time), twins that produce additional costs of between \$3,000 and \$8,000 (happens about 40% of the time) travel of \$4000 for donors (happens about 50% of the time), travel of \$5000 for carriers (happens about 80% of the time, unless you are willing to wait an extra couple of months for a local carrier), and choosing a more expensive clinic (happens about 80% of the time)**
